

## Dear Friend of PSP,

2007 was People Serving People's 25th Anniversary, marking a significant milestone in the community. PSP has provided quality emergency housing and services to the homeless now for over two decades.

### **We have come a long way.**

PSP was incorporated and received its non-profit status in 1982, as a temporary homeless shelter for men with chemical dependencies. Progressively over the past twenty years PSP has moved from serving individuals to

### **helping families with children.**

To accommodate this shift in services, in 2002, People Serving People renovated and moved into its new location at 614 South Third Street. The facility was crafted so that collaborative agencies can be housed on-site. Our current facility has ten floors, offering 99 hotel-size rooms and ten two-bedroom apartments for homeless families. There are four service floors containing a dining room, two libraries, several classrooms, medical clinic, two children's centers, a computer lab, and more.

### **With each passing year, we are proud to be able to respond and adapt to the needs of the homeless community.**

In recent years, we have taken a more holistic approach. We are excited for the future and have many plans to build upon and improve our services.

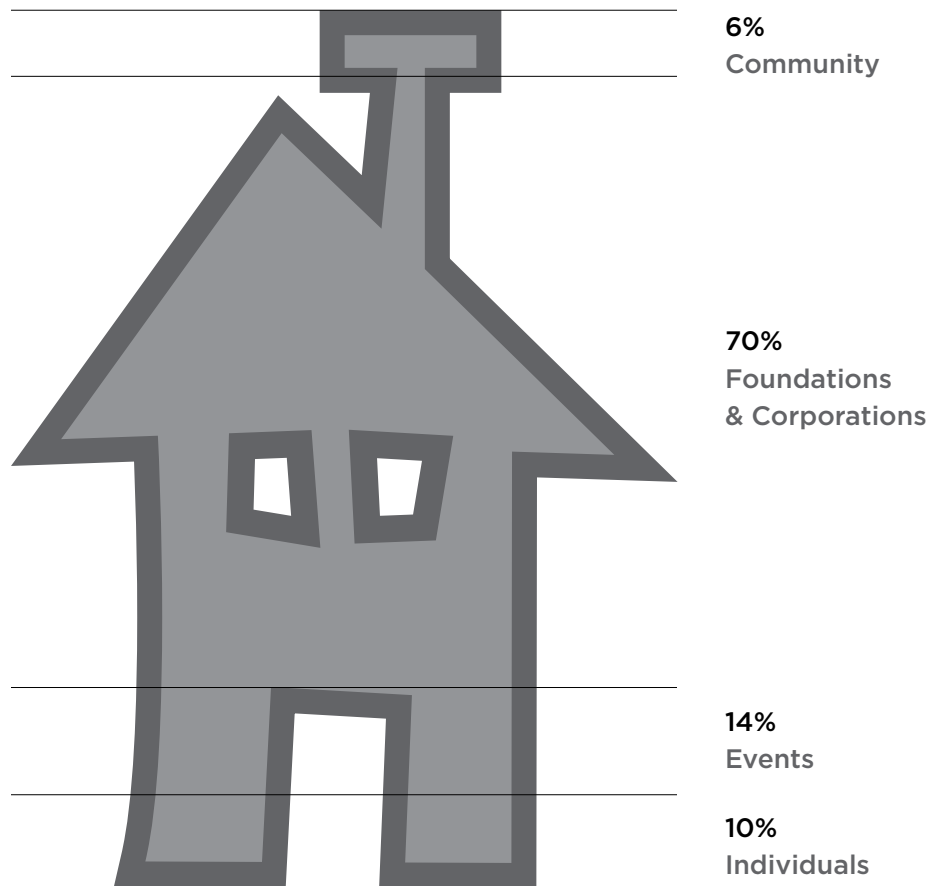
