- 4) Difficulty breathing (severe cases)



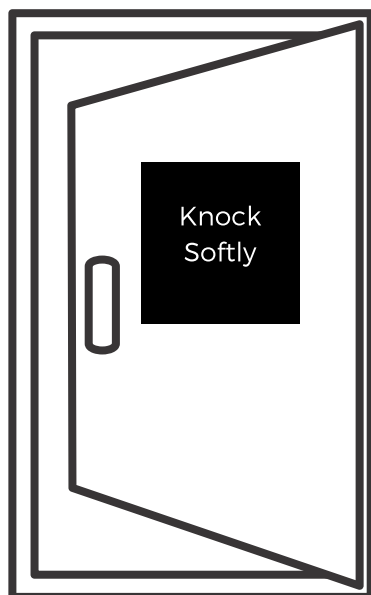
## Meal Signs on Doors
