

I couldn't always see myself in a role like this. In fact, I wasn't sure I would be here at all. When I was five, I spent nights forced to sleep outside, wrapped in a blanket because there was nowhere else to go, chewing my forest green sweatshirt because there was nothing to eat.



As a kid, I remember thinking that if I wasn't here anymore, no one would notice. But someone did notice. I went to school for the first time at age 8. A teacher saw me and triggered the help that saved my life.

Maybe that teacher was like you - someone who can see the pain of homelessness. That teacher took action, like you have by engaging with People Serving People, and started working to change what they saw. After that teacher noticed me, I made a vow: I would spend my life making sure that kids like me were seen and cared for.


That's why I'm here, leading People Serving People. And that's why I'm asking you to join me in seeing the families in our community who are homeless. I'm asking you to acknowledge their existence - to fight for them - with your donation.

We are working to make sure that families never experience homelessness again. We're raising wages to ensure our staff won't wonder if they might need our help, expanding our reach by operating two shelters, our downtown Minneapolis location and St. Anne's Place in North Minneapolis.
