## **Project Overview**

Potty training can be stressful for both parents and the child. With these potty training kits, we can equip families with the right tools to help make their child's transition go as smooth as possible. These kits also ensure that children can utilize the toilets within their units' bathroom.

Note: Please assemble gender neutral kits OR a mix of boys' and girls' kits

- 1 Potty Seat
- 5 Pull-Ups
- 5 Pack of Underwear
- 1 Potty Book
- 1 Reusable Tote Bag

# **Decorated Tote Bags (Optional)**



There are two ways your group can partake in this project:

- 1. If you are looking for ways to prolong your volunteer event for an extended timeframe, we recommend decorating canvas tote bags. This will offer a sit-down component to the activity while adding additional value to your Potty Training Kits.
- 2. If you or your group are not interested in decorating, you can purchase regular tote bags for your kits. In this scenario, your team will primarily assemble Potty Training kits in an assembly line fashion.

#### We recommend these additional supplies for decorating the reusable canvas tote bags:

- Blank Canvas Tote Bags
- Fabric Markers
- Stencils
- · Basket for Markers
- Note Cards

# **Step #1: Volunteer Activity Setup**

To ensure a smooth flow of your group activity, we recommend your team dedicates time beforehand to set-up the event before getting started. On the next page, you will find a recommended layout that we find works best for volunteer groups.


Using this layout, volunteers can begin by seating themselves at the tables designated for tote bag decorating (if applicable). Once they've completed their bags, they can then head to assembly line and begin filling the tote with Potty Training kit supplies.

# **Step #2: Starting the Event**

Before your team of volunteers starts on the activity, we recommend a leader in your group shares more about how Potty Training Kits are utilized in People Serving People's programming. Take some time to provide your volunteer group with instructions on how the activity is designed to flow.

**Assembly Lines** 

If your group is decorating canvas tote bags, please ensure they create child-friendly designs. Please avoid religious messages.



**Note:** Be sure volunteers label each bag with a note card that includes which size and gender items are including in their Potty Training Kit.

### **Step #3: Post Event**
